Greetings Get in Gear Corporate Team Members,

We are happy to have you join us on Sat, Apr 29 as part of a corporate team for the Get in Gear Races and specifically for our 40th Annual celebration.

Packet Pickup and Parking

You may pick up your packet at Minnehaha Falls park pavilion from noon – 8 PM on Friday, April 28th or on Saturday morning from 7:00 AM to 9:15 AM. Your packet will need to be picked up individually, either by you or someone you designate.

Get in Gear will absorb the cost of parking in the park on Friday, April 28 from sun up until sun down in designated areas that are on Godfrey Boulevard. Two parking lots on the north side of the Pavilion (approximately 250 parking spots) are free to our participants beginning at noon. Additionally, the parking lots closer to 46th and Godfrey are also available for parking on Friday free of charge. Please note that parking is NOT allowed in the bus circle and that the parking spots adjacent to the Pavilion (west side and on Old Minnehaha) are not part of the paid parking for the day.

There is limited packet pickup on race morning, starting at 7 AM. If you must pick up your packet at this time, allow time to get your race number and get to the start line. All races will start on time.

Race Day

Parking is available free at the VA Medical Center and shuttles will bring you to the park before the race and return you to the VA Medical Center after the race. This is a great way to make sure your vehicle is secure and protected while you race. The distance is approximately one mile and there are 10 chartered school buses available for the shuttle from the VAMC to the drop off point at Minnehaha Park.

All teams are encouraged to visit our Photo Stand for a team photo in front of our Get in Gear background! Additionally, one of our sponsors, Summit Orthopedics will have a Photo Booth so utilize both options for some extra fun. We ask that you send pictures of your team to our office for use in social media and our website regarding our corporate challenge.

The Corporate staging area is located behind the pavilion next to the falls. Look for your corporate team sign to assemble your team. These are placed in alphabetical order.

All races will start on time. The construction around the site and near the bridge will not impede our races and more information on this will be in the general e-mail you will receive as a registrant of the Get in Gear.

Corporate Challenge Awards

All corporate teams are eligible for corporate age group awards.

In addition, if your team meets the following qualifications, it will be considered for the Summit Orthopedics Fastest Team and Highest Percent Participation Awards:

- Team must have least 3 men and 3 women competing in any combination of the 5K, 10K or Half Marathon races
- Team must have at least 25 employees in the local (upper Midwest) office to be eligible for scoring

The winning teams will receive a plaque and 5 free entries to next year's race.

Team Captains, please send an email to giginfo@getingear-events.com with your company's number of local (upper Midwest) employees for tabulation of results. We will need this information for processing official awards post-race.
